Please follow the directions for each set of questions. The corresponding verse from the lesson is provided in parenthesis.

Multiple Choice: For the following 5 questions, please write the letter that is most correct on the line.

- Christ is the author of eternal salvation to all who obey \_\_\_\_\_. (Hebrews 5:9)
  - their own beliefs
  - Calvinist doctrine

  - just a symbolic commitment to a specific denomination and can be done once they have already said a prayer and accepted Jesus
  - an obedient response to the commands of Christ and is how one is saved when they are immersed in water for the forgiveness of sins after they have believed, repented, and confessed that Jesus Christ is the Son of God
- If someone is baptized for any other reasons other than to be saved in Christ Jesus, then \_\_\_\_\_. (Acts 19:3-5, 1 Peter 3:21, Galatians 3:27)
  - they are still saved as long as they feel fine with their decision
  - it really doesn't matter because baptism is overrated by narrow minded people and God does not clearly state its necessity
  - they should answer their conscience by obeying the commands of Christ and be baptized into Christ for the remission of sins
  - they are still saved because at least they were immersed in water
